





WHY

Our mission is to equip kids to better understand themselves and the world around them through the power of **film and creative media**. Our programs support the **mental health** and **emotional intelligence** of kids through entertaining and thought-provoking stories that spark wonder and foster resilience.



WHY?

The inaugural Like You Children's Film Festival Will be held November 22-23, 2025 at the MoSH Pink Palace Museum.
